Close to 80 community owned and managed homestays were started in 6 villages of Spiti back in 2004. Homestays are now supplementing between 50 to 80% of annual household incomes, which forms a huge support now in the face of the ever changing climate and its impact on agriculture. Tourism is now used as a tool to address conservation concerns related to fading cultural traditions, identity and knowledge; addressing conservation concerns focused around the wildlife, ecology and geological wealth of these regions. Experiences and immersions in local culture, monastic life, wildlife, sharing traditional knowledge and ways of life on the one hand provide monies for communities and on the other become a reason to conserve, be it their culture or natural heritage or the wildlife and environment which are the very resources on which the tourism industry thrives. They work with the potter in Langza, Bhuchen of the Pin Valley, Folk dancers of Demul among many others. At Ecosphere, they carefully calculate the carbon emitted on their trips, which is then neutralized by investments in direct carbon reducing green technologies within the region enabling a more green and sustainable development in the region as well. Some of their initiatives include-Building of Solar Passive Winter Rooms, Solar Baths and Greenhouses to reduce carbon emissions in the Valley. They also work on immediate needs of villages such as healthcare, animal care and education.

Ms. Jasmeen Patheja

Jasmeen Patheja is an artist based in India. She is the founder and facilitator of Blank Noise; a community of 'Action Heroes', citizens and individuals, united to eradicate sexual and gender based violence. Patheja founded Blank Noise in 2003, as a response to daily experiences of street harassment. Since its inception, Patheja has designed a range of interventions and projects that enable public discourse on sexual violence. Projects range across forms of media and communities (performance, videos, live action, t-shirts, installation, murals, posters) and are focused towards bringing attitudinal shifts. Noise. Jasmeen's project "Talk To Me" was the recipient of the International Award For Public Art 2015. Jasmeen Patheja's work has been featured in the media extensively including NDTV, CNNIBN, BBC, The Atlantic, The Hindu, Salon, Elle, Vogue, India Today. Patheja is also a photographer and shares an ongoing photo performance project with her grandmother/ collaborator.

Passionate about her work, she values honesty, commitment, discipline, respect, compassion and dedication and is inspired by the changes brought about by Mahatma Gandhi, Abraham Lincoln, Nelson Mandela and Dalai Lama.

Mr. Anurag Chauhan

Anurag Chauhan, a young pursuant of Bachelors in Social Work, began his journey of serving the society at a tender age of 16. He founded *Humans for Humanity*, to work on the social issues and aims to *spread happiness and smiles*. The organization works to engage the youth from different professions and geographic locations in the country, such as in Delhi, Bangalore, Rajasthan, Uttarakhand and Uttar Pradesh. It also hosts volunteers from 14 countries, like China, Argentina, Spain, Afghanistan, Brazil, Bahrain, Lesotho, Germany, Indonesia, Columbia, Egypt and Italy, who work on different projects under an internship program. The following day, he and his friends in the band received accolades and were featured in The Statesman. Years and many awards and recognitions later, that day still holds special in his heart. Mr. Akash Bhardwaj

Akash Bhardwaj is the founder and CEO of KHASS (meaning Special), a unique Tour and Travel Agency that provides employment only to visually impaired women and acid attack survivors. An encounter with an acid attack survivor, in Delhi, during Diwali one year, who had explained how she was abandoned by her family and employer and was forced on the street with the responsibility of two children, after she lost face value in the attack, inspired Akash to provide a platform to the visually challenged and acid attack survivors to regain their confidence and lead a respectable and independent life. With the help of the JAWS (Job Access With Speech) programme, he trains his special team with 'dedication enough to care and passionate enough to deliver.' He is determined and dedicates his life to seeking and implementing new ideas for women safety and empowerment and dreams of a world where every visually challenged or acid attack survivor will be included in the working module. His belief in inclusion rather than alienation or rejection of people, has also led him to start Parivartan, a training program that aims to train 'rejected interview candidates', preparing them for interviews in corporates. In addition, Akash also stands for animal welfare and civil rights and social action and believes in giving everybody a chance.

Mr. Babar Ali

Babar Ali is an educationist, who at a tender age of 16, earned the title of being the Youngest Headmaster in the World. Hailing from the minority community dominated village of Gangpur in West Bengal, he was born the eldest of the four children to a small-time jute trader. Realizing the need for educating young minds, he taught his first class, under a guava tree, with eight children from the village, free of cost, at the age of just nine years. Today, after fourteen years, Ali has taught over 3000 children in the Murshidabad district of West Bengal. "Education for all"/"Education for poor children" is his life's mission and passion. Mr. Sai Prasad Vishwanathan

Sai Prasad Vishwanathan, recipient of multiple awards including the Helen Keller Role Model Person of the Year Award 2010 & I.S.B.'s Torch Bearer Leadership Award 2011, attracted the imagination of the world through his indomitable spirit and self-belief in dealing with physical disabilities. He is the first Indian with a disability to step onto the Antarctic continent and the first to skydive from 14,000 feet. He has been featured in the television program, Satyameva Jayate, which he says gave him the opportunity to raise the concern over our country's infrastructural disability. Sai was born with severe physical challenges, as a result of which, he was refused admission to several high schools. But he and his parents never gave up and today his achievements speak for themselves. A gold medalist from CBIT, a summa-cum-laude research scholar & M.S. Computer Science from University of Wisconsin, and an MBA from ISB, Sai began his career last year at Deloitte as a campus hire. "The number of times you are hurt, insulted and fail -- will not matter on the day you achieve that, which your heart most truly wants," he says. Sai is also an adventure lover. In 2008, while in the U.S., he became the first physically-challenged Indian to skydive from 14, 000 feet, which earned him a citation in the Limca Book of Records. In 2009, he went scuba diving and in 2012, he explored the Grand Canyons and its billion year sediments in a chopper ride. 'The goal is to explore and experience all the five elements that constitutes life -- earth, water, fire, sky and air', he says. Sai also dreamt of becoming an entrepreneur and in 2009-10, he consulted Wadhwani foundation & the Home Ministry to create a business model that promotes employment for physically challenged people. He also co-founded a venture called 'Sahasra' that provides scholarships to meritorious and financially backward students. to help them pursue higher education. Sahasra, today, has helped more than 15,000 students.

Dr. Satendra Singh

Satendra Singh is best described as a healer (medical doctor), a teacher, a crusader for the rights of the disabled, an advocate of medical humanities and a life-long learner. Even before he could celebrate his first birthday he was infected with the poliovirus, which although did result in his physical impairment, has also been key for shaping his determination to become a medical doctor. Today, he is an Associate Professor of Physiology at University College of Medical Sciences & GTB Hospital, Delhi. He is also an executive member of the Statutory Delhi Medical Council, Co-coordinator of Medical Education Unit, UCMS and the Associate Editor of Research & Humanities in Medical Education. His own life experience has led him to realize the need and has led him to become a crusader for the rights of the disabled. He set up the Enabling Unit (for persons with disabilities) and co-founded Medical Humanities Group at his institution. He also successfully persuaded the Ministry of Health to unlock 1,674 central posts for doctors with disabilities. His unrelenting efforts resulted in India's

2014 General Elections in Delhi to be *disabled friendly* and earned him a nomination for the National Awards 2015, by the recommendation of Mr. Vijay Dev, the Chief Electoral Officer. It is his advocacy that led the Medical Council of India to issue directives to all the medical institutions in India to be *disabled friendly* and UPSC to remove the discriminatory performa asking candidates with disabilities to attach photograph showing their disability. In 2013, he also received the NCPEDEP MphasiS Universal Design Award for his contributions to bring about a change.

Mr. Sujith Kumar

Sujith Kumar has over 17 years of experience in Human Resources, designing and implementing Employee Engagement Initiatives, Change Management, Performance Management, Employee Relations & Labour Law, Internal Communications, Branding, Corporate Social Responsibility and Training & Development. A Post Graduate in Social Work, with specialization in Personnel Management & Industrial Relations, he has worked with Infosys for over 15 years and is currently their HR Business Leader for global sales. He is a prominent speaker in various student and industry forums and spends his weekends speaking to young minds in colleges. Also, a regular speaker in business conclaves such as NAASCOM, NHRD, FICCI & CII, he has been featured in several TV and Radio Talk shows. He is the Founder and Managing Trustee of Maatram Foundation which provides free higher education to meritorious and underprivileged students that has benefited more than 337 students in the last 4 years. The foundation also aims to setup school libraries in select Government Corporation Schools. Currently, he is a member of several Academic councils of Engineering colleges, in steering committee of the NAASCOM CSR Chapter, NAASCOM HR Forum for Chennai and an Honorary President of the Chennai chapter of the National HRD network. In addition, he also offers his service to their National Board and writes for several magazines and newspapers. His accolades include the Infosys Award for Excellence for 3 consecutive years for his innovative initiatives in employee engagement and people management, the Young Achiever Award & ICON of Rotaract by Rotary International for his outstanding work with the student community, the NASSCOM Special Recognition award in 2011 and the Change Maker Award in 2014.

Ms. Kanksshi Agarwal

Kanksshi Agarwal is a 23 year old electrical engineer with a post-graduation in power system. She is currently pursuing her second masters in urban policy and governance at TISS Mumbai. She is an exuberant and enthusiastic writer/ poet and an aspiring youth icon. She has been a founder of two entities, AIESEC and SAFAR, and succeeded to become the first president of AIESEC in Bhopal. She has been a content writer for a few forums, and wishes to write heart-touching stories all her life. She is a blogger and has contributed to your story, one framestories and other websites. She has hosted a few events like M.P. Youth parliament conducted by MIT, Pune and college events. She is a theatre artist. She is sensitive towards human settlements, women empowerment (worked for HeForShe UN women campaign),

mental disorders, sanitations and hygiene, skill development, entrepreneurship-incubators, creative space creations etc. She has keen interests in Financial analysis (economics), Business Development, PR and marketing. To create awareness about body donation, Kartheeban donated the bodies of his parents to Theni Medical College. He donated his parent's home to the community. It is called 'Mom Dad Community Center' which is now a computer center, a yoga center and a study center, benefitting 500 children a year. After marriage, he added his wife's name to his name, changing it from 'Kartheeban' to 'Karthee Vidya'. He quit his high paid MNC job to spend his time to promote volunteering. He does part time jobs to earn his living.

Mr. Kevval Liladhar Hariya

Kevval Liladhar Hariya is the founder of Udaan entertainment Asia LLP and Udaan entertainment group. He is the major driving force and the reason behind the growth as well as the current status of the company. Having lost his eye sight at the age of six, Kevval's life has been full of difficulties and challenges. His parents found out a special school for him soon after he lost his sight. He settled down in the school after few initial hick ups and concentrated on constantly improving his academic performances. He passed SSC, HSC and the graduation years with fairly good results. Since the formation of his company, he, along with his team, has accomplished many things like getting opportunities to be a part of many television shows, releasing an instrumental album through t-series and so on. As a leader, Kevval believes that honesty, loyalty and sincerity are the most important human values and without them one can't achieve anything in life. He has empowered the people with disability by nurturing and flourishing their innermost talent and compelled the world to recognize them as real wealth. He advocates and promotes good qualities, thoughts, talent etc which he believes are essential for the betterment of the mankind.

Mr. Kumar Shanu

Kumar Shanu is a lawyer by profession and an activist by passion. He is the founder of Whistle for Public Interest-WHIP, an organisation representing public spirited law students. He had fought for the Rights of more than 50 Lakh students who appeared for the exams conducted by CBSE to access their evaluated answer-sheets under RTI. The apex court of the country, in response to his petition, held that answer scripts be made available to students via the RTI Act, if a request is made within the period of three months for which the answerbooks are maintained by the CBSE. He has been consistent in providing legal assistance to public at large in the matters of RTI, Consumer Protection, PILs and have appeared and argued before the Central Information Commission, Consumer Foras, Delhi High Court and Supreme Court of India during his stay at law school. The Delhi High Court in the year 2016 oversaw the amendment of its own RTI Rules after a writ petition was filed by him and other members of WHIP. The RTI fees in the Courts of Delhi, have been harmonised with the RTI Act and a provision to make information free for BPL applicants has been inserted. In second year of law school, Kumar along with his fellow batch-mates, established Legal Aid Cell, through which they organized several legal aid and awareness camps in juvenile homes, factories, government schools, aaganwardis and different village panchayats of Noida and provided legal assistance to several Under-Trial Prisoners and Juveniles. A theatre artist, Kumar has also been using his skits and plays as medium of spreading legal awareness.

Ms. Lovita J R Morang

Lovita J R Morang is a professional filmmaker, artiste, writer and a poet. She has written twenty-three books, Anthologies of poetries and short stories that she shares with renowned poets of the world. Her work has been represented on international and National film/literary festivals. Mr. Nipun Malhotra

Nipun Malhotra is co-founder and CEO of the Nipman Foundation that works in the area of health and advocacy for Persons with Disabilities. He is a visiting Research Fellow at World Enabled, a Pineda Foundation initiative. He is the brand ambassador of Umoja Travels, India's first accessible travel company and is on the board of Directors at Vishwas, a non-profit working on disability and development. Malhotra is also the Executive Director of Nipman Fastener Industries - a leading automotive fastener manufacturing company in India. Nipun is an alumnus of St. Stephen's College and the Delhi School of Economics. He is a World Economic Forum Global Shaper. Since 2015, Nipun has been at the forefront of numerous efforts to ensure access for the disabled. The wheelchair access filters in restaurant listings on Zomato, the availability of wheelchairs at the recent NH7 and the Jaipur Literature Festival, are direct results. He also lobbied with the Delhi Government to get the Disabled exempted from the Odd-Even car rule. An avid tweeter, Nipun writes regularly on Disability issues. His writing has appeared on Scroll.in, the Indian Express, NDTV Blog etc. He has also authored a comic titled 'No red card for the disabled'. Nipun was born with Arthrogryposis, a rare congenital disorder. He is a wheelchair user.

Mr. Pramod Minocha

Pramod Minocha has been an Initiater of change for making Greater Faridabad a liveable and prosperous place. Holding multiple portfolios as President - Greater Faridabad Residents Welfare Association, President - Rotary club of Faridabad Green, MD - Domarp Pharmaceutical private company, Pramod has painstakingly brought revolutionary changes in Greater Faridabad by fighting for people's rights with the corrupt top players, introducing basic sanitation measures, amenities, environment friendly drives, healthcare facilities and many more. Mr. Pravin Sanjay Nikam

Pravin Nikam, a young change maker whose vision was clear right from the start that girls have a self-evident right to education. This made him to start ROSHNI an organization by the name of the girl he met in Assam, via which he started providing education to children and improving health conditions of teenage girls and women. He empowered them on issues around menstrual management and reproductive health rights, working for disability rights, prevention of alcoholism and substance (drugs) abuse and working for citizen's rights, also motivating the youth to actively participate in smooth functioning of democracy. Pravin Nikam was awarded the Highest Youth Award given by Government of India i.e National Youth Award for the Year 2014-2015 for his great contribution to Humanity. Pravin Nikam is global youth activist, community mobilizer and strategist advocating for democratic sustainability, youth and human rights, gender justice, accountability, transparency and youth engagement in the development discourse, championing global and local (GLOCAL) change.

Today, almost 85 children, between 4 to 18 years of age, are part of the family, living with emotional, spiritual love and affection with no barriers of caste or creed. He aspires to increase the capacity so that more and more children can become part of the family. However, the lack of government funds has been a deterrent to his dream but Santosh remains determined. Presently, and for the last 12 years, the finances of the *pariwar* have been supported through donations made by generous members of the community. He has been honoured by many awards such as the Mahamanav Baba Amte Manavta Puraskar (2011), SAKAL vardhapan - dinanimitt Sevagaurav purskar (2011), Sva. Chimanlal Govindas seva-gaurav Puraskar (2010), Youth Kranti Award (2012), MGM Sakshama Sanman (2013), Sarvottam Seva Puraskar (2014), Shaskiy Tantraniketan Sanman Chinha (2014), Vedh Foundation JIwan Gourav award (2014), Rajystariya Kaamgar Bhushan (2014), Marathwada Bhushan Purskar (2015), Tyagmurti Maharshi Dadhichi award (2016), to name just a few. A believer in love, kindness and equality, Santosh aspires to spread love, peace and harmony in society.

Ms. Sanya Chawla

class board exams. Despite his physical challenges and dependency on others, Shorya travels independently to his college and is a source of inspiration for others. His hobbies include debating, reading and playing chess. He was the general Secretary of his department, a member of his college debate and chess teams and has represented his college in inter-college debates and chess competitions. He is the co-founder of I-Kiran foundation that works for the marginalised sections of the society, looking after the education of poor and underprivileged children. He aspires to work for the upliftment of poor and differently-abled people and for women empowerment, fighting inequality, corruption and injustice. He hopes to involve himself in the education of the underprivileged and differently abled and spread awareness against the archaic patriarchal mindset of society, especially in rural India. He also hopes to educate people about the rights as a citizen and ensure speedy justice to all sections of society.

Ms. Sonal Giani

An Indian-Canadian is an accomplished management consultant, social activist and coach and mentor, training individuals (especially young women) in the areas of confidence building, communication and positive thinking. She is known for her initiatives against domestic violence in the community and runs workshops for low-income young women in partnership with the NGO, Udayan Care. His early interest in art was encouraged by his parents and he gradually climbed the steps of artdom formally in 1997, when he graduated with BFA, from College of Art, New Delhi. He was honoured with the Vice Chancellor Award in 1997, for his academic performance at BFA in the final year, in College of Art New Delhi. Since then he has not looked back. He will also soon be seen in an online series 'Love, Life and Screw Ups'. He has also worked in TV commercials for brands like Maruti Suzuki, MTV India, Channel V India, Idea mobiles etc. Alongside acting and TV, he took notice of his singing talent and won several awards and titles between 2011 and 2013. In 2015, he was the guest in Colors TV's India's Got Talent and Zoom's Style Pang.a He was also the guest in the grand finale of &TV's Killerr Karaoke Atka Toh Latkah. Two documentary films, both based on his life have been nominated and screened at various national and international festivals. A positive guy, who loves to spread positivity around, Sushant represents the LGBT community of India. He holds double Masters in psychology and is now pursuing a PhD in the same field. He aspires to work for Women Empowerment in addition to supporting the LGBT community.

Master Ved Chikarmane

Ved is a 4th grade student at Mallya Aditi International School, Bangalore. He is an avid sportsman with a special liking towards cricket. He is part of the school Under 12 team, has a lot of friends and does well in school. He was diagnosed with partial bi-lateral hearing loss for which he wears hearing aids in both ears and leads and enjoys life. Initially, he was silent, withdrawn, frustrated and an overactive kid, who needed his family by his side to interpret anything anyone told him. But a trip to the US when he was 4 years old, became his turning point. During his visit, he met Dr Bernstein, head of Paediatric Audiology at Columbia, who fitted him with paediatric aids (the ones he had on was for geriatrics). He was also introduced to Lois Heymann, a speech therapist, who went on to turn Ved into a bubbly, enthusiastic, sociable and confident boy. Through her research and sessions, she helped Ved learn strategies and gave him confidence to dream and believe that he can become anything he so pleases. Having learnt from his own experience, this little boy now wishes to spread awareness about this disability in India and open Lois' centres in India to help kids with partial hearing loss become part of the mainstream.

Mr. Vijay Pentareddy

Vijay is a 15 year IT Professional, who worked with fortune 500 companies globally providing his consulting services through Wipro and Accenture. Realizing how fresh graduates from college lacked the skills required in the professional world, he quit his job to start his organization, Last Mile, where he aims to bridge this gap. Today, Last Mile has a 70% placement record with 500+ placements. However, his initial days were full of struggles. He used social media platforms, like facebook, to create his group KAIZEN which now has 25,000 members to revolutionize the approach of reaching out to student and mentoring them in their careers. He started his training in his garage and today has influenced 4000+ youth in getting. Majority of his students are from financially underprivileged background and from villages. Vijay believes that everyone can get through interviews irrelevant of their background as long as they have the will. Vijay also made a short film "Road of Spero" which has revolutionized the approach of inspiring youth. He used the concept of flipped class training model, by giving more time to students for hands on approach in training so that they can excel at work and yes they have. He expand and reach out to more student, he approached the State government, who was also impressed and approved a pilot project to train students in one district, fully funded by govt. with only marginal costs to youth from rural areas. The success of this pilot project earned him a spot amongst the Indian Express list of top 16 people who will influence India in 2016.

When she is not working, Deepa does all a mother should, while championing the cause of hearing impaired children in a system and society where the support for this disability is lacking.

Mr. Yashveer Chaudhry

Yashveer has gone through a lot of personal struggle and strives to become a better human being everyday from the learning that he received from pain. From being a child who never spoke for years due to trauma, he went on to become the NIOS Representative, a member of the Student Council. From being put in a class of children with special needs in childhood, he went on to top his class in his class 12 boards, and has received an academic scholarship from his university. Today, he voluntarily helps out underprivileged patients at a charitable health care centre in Himachal Pradesh every year. He also counsels students with special needs as an alumnus of his school. Yashveer is there for everyone who needs him and seeks to better himself as well as society to the best of his ability. Having gone through emotional and sociological problems, he thinks the greatest role that he could play is when he interacts and tries to help people with special needs such as autism, asperger's syndrome etc, a responsibility he especially fulfilled during his tenure as National Institute of Open Schooling Representative at The Shri Ram School. A proud Indian, he hopes to make his country proud by doing good to society.

She used to voluntarily give moral teaching in the early morning assembly which is normally not the part of any study curriculum. She used to Anchor all the cultural programs of the school. She has written poetry books (Dil se Dil ki Baat) on the reality of life and how to improve the quality of life. She has also written books containing bhajans (Bhajnamrit) which she published at her own cost and circulated free of cost to various people. Currently she is writing a novel. Rahul could not come to terms with not only the lack of information but also support for cancer patients in India. During the 15 rounds of chemotherapy, he met fellow cancer patients at the hospital with whom he initiated a small patient support group. Today, his initiative, known as 'Yoddhas' or warriors is a one-of-itskind online support group where cancer patients in India can connect with each other and find the information and support they need. For Rahul, it is all about providing a cancer patient with all the support she/he needs. In its short existence of less than 1 year, Yoddhas has enabled people battling cancer to come out of their shell, shed social stigma attached to their condition and find a place to voice their experiences and help each other along this tough journey.

Vocational skills included tailoring, knitting, making stuffed toys etc. To encourage arts and culture ARYAA CULTURAL ACADEMY started and every year organized many cultural programs, competitions and debates for children. Apart from above the heartfelt project started ANTHARMUKHA the silent victims started 2 years back with the objective to prevent , protect and heal children from child abuse.
