Government of Telangana. Vishy is also directly involved in rescuing children in collaboration with an NGO Aide et Action from brick kiln who were continuously raped and abused by the owner in Choppdandi, Karimnagar. The case is booked under POSCO and is in courts.

Ms. Uttara Singh

Uttara is an educator who has been in this field of education for the last 25 years. She has taught children of all ages from 3 years old to 17 years old and she connects equally well with them. She likes to think that children recognize that she understands them and she loves them for what they are. Today as she heads a school, her children are her pride. She has tried to instil in them a confidence and awareness of themselves. They are asked not to fear any individual figure of authority but to fear the consequences of wrong behaviour. She loves listening to their suggestions and thoughts and they have implemented many a change thanks to their inputs. The children speak their minds and value and respect their elders. She believes that her team is the most important factor in the creation of their beautiful institute – they have educators who believe in the children and she is very proud of the environment that they have created together. She is definitely a team player who leads from within the team – not from the front! Her main job description would be- to keep it all together with the team moving towards a common goal, with a common purpose, feeling valued and contributing to the success achieved, meeting personal goals along with the common mission.
